Social Services Sunday: Anchors of Hope

Today is Social Services Sunday in the Catholic Archdiocese of Melbourne. In this Jubilee Year of Hope and on this day, we give thanks for the dedicated work of the thousands of staff and volunteers who stand with and serve the poor, disadvantaged and marginalised in Victoria, reaching the lives of more than 300,000 people each year, and bringing hope to the most vulnerable in our community every day.

We recognise and appreciate their commitment and compassion, and reflect on our shared call to be anchors of hope in building a more just and equitable society. How might we better support each other to support those doing it tough in our communities and society?

- Catholic social service organisations in Victoria provide services from caring for lonely neighbours, to assisting those fleeing domestic violence, people experiencing homelessness, asylum seekers and refugees, and families and children in difficulty.
- CSSV's 2024 report on the work of our 40+ member organisations show that Victoria's Catholic social service organisations collectively:
 - o Supported more than 302,500 people (more than 4.5% of Victoria's population)
 - o Employed 7510 staff
 - o Had over 15,800 volunteers
 - o Worked from over 150 sites across Victoria
 - o Spent \$898 million on providing these services with \$611 million (68%) provided by government.
- These organisations provided services in over 30 different areas of work: from early intervention and prevention to crisis response.

Despite the significant difference Catholic social services make in Victoria there are still enormous pressures being placed on our communities with the cost of living and ongoing housing crisis, and fractures in our society creating a sense of disrupted social cohesion.

For this reason, CSSV, as a peak body for Catholic agencies working across the state, promotes a just, equitable and compassionate society where all can flourish.

Everyone can be an anchor of hope for the poor, disadvantaged and vulnerable, by collaborating with and supporting Catholic social services in your community and beyond, and taking other actions for a just society.
