Today in Rome, Pope Leo XIV will canonise Bl. Carlo Acutis and Bl. Pier Giorgio Frassati as his first Saints. (10:00 am Rome time - 6:00 pm Melbourne time - Ceremony can be viewed on Vatican website, vatican.va)

Saint Carlo Acutis



Carlo Acutis was born in London in 1991 and raised in Milan. He loved football, Pokémon, action movies, and animals. But from early childhood, his heart belonged to Jesus in the Eucharist. Though his parents were not practising Catholics, Carlo's devotion was instinctive. He insisted on visiting churches to 'say hello to Jesus,' which eventually led both his mother and father back to the faith.

At age 7, he received his First Holy Communion in a convent. From then on, daily Mass, Eucharistic Adoration, and the Rosary became central to his life. He often said: 'The Eucharist is my highway to Heaven!'


At age 11, he began cataloguing Eucharistic miracles and developed a website and exhibition — now displayed worldwide, to help others recognise that Jesus is truly present in the Blessed Sacrament. A gifted student and programmer, Carlo also practiced great discipline. Though he enjoyed video games, he limited himself to one hour a week, devoting his time to prayer, study, and service to the poor, the elderly, and classmates in need. He defended the disabled, stood up for Catholic teaching, and treated everyone with kindness and respect.

In October 2006, at age 15, Carlo was diagnosed with a sudden and aggressive leukemia. He offered his suffering for the Pope and the Church, saying: 'I am happy to die, because I have lived my life without wasting even a minute on things that do not please God.'

Carlo died on 12 October 2006, and is buried in Assisi.

Saint Pier Giorgio Frassati




Pier Giorgio Frassati was born in Turin on 6 April 1901. His mother was a painter, his father an Italian senator, owner and editor of 'La Stampa' newspaper.

Pier Giorgio developed a deep spirituality from an early age, focused on the Eucharist and devotion to Mary. At 17, he joined the St Vincent de Paul Society. Much of his spare time was spent serving the poor and sick, his life of charity being nourished by daily Communion and nocturnal Eucharistic Adoration. In 1922 he became a third order (lay) Dominican.

At university in Turin, Frassati studied mining engineering, and also became involved in social and political activism, promoting the Church's social teaching through the Catholic Student Foundation, Catholic Action and the People's Party. In the political struggles of the time, he stood up against fascism. He was an enthusiastic mountain climber and athlete, as well as a lover of art, music and theatre.

Shortly before graduating, he contracted polio. After a short illness of severe suffering, Pier Giorgio died on 4 July 1925, aged 24. At his funeral, great numbers lined the streets of Turin, especially the poor and needy whom he had helped.

On 31 March 1981, his body was exhumed - standard procedure for a cause of canonisation - and was found to be completely intact and incorrupt. Beatified by Pope John Paul II on 20 May 1990, he is now buried in Turin Cathedral.
